A. Discussion of Next Steps for Employee Interchange Agreement with Monroe County

Village Attorney John Quick noted that Monroe County had agreed to lend Director of Human Services Bryan Cook to serve as the Interim Village Manager

for a term of 60 days which is renewable at the Council's discretion for up to two years. The annual salary for Mr. Cook's service would be \$248,000, based on Mr. Yates' salary and housing allowance. His start date would be Monday, August 7.

Mr. Cook's County work would not be chargeable to the Village - he would be required to log his time while serving as manager.
