I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 am. Vice Chair Barbara Edgar, Commissioner Roland Moore, Commissioner Tammie Gurgiolo, Planner Heidi Harum and Planning Coordinator Anita Muxo were present. Absent / excused was Megan Scallan. Absent was Angel Borden. Also present was Council Liaison to the committee Henry Rosenthal.

IV. MINUTES

December 18, 2023 meeting minutes – Tammie Gurgiolo made a motion to approve, Roland Moore seconded the motion. A vote was taken, all ayes and the motion passed 3 – 0.

V. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

A. Election of Chair

A motion was made to nominate Barbara Edgar for Chair and Tammie Gurgiolo for Vice Chair. A vote was taken and the motion passed.

B. Storyboards and map update.

The storyboards are up. Barbara Edgar will contact the map maker as to the status of the map.

C. Is the Committee interested in working on:

Roland Moore mentioned capturing Islamorada on canvas. Mr. Moore also suggested considering a walking tour of Islamorada. In addition, he mentioned creating a book or brochure of historical homes.

Barbara Edgar asked if the Art Guild was working on placing art in Islamorada.

Ms. Edgar said they are working on getting a new trolley and will restart the tours once the trolley is up and running.

Barbara Edgar mentioned that Centennial and State Banks produced a calendar but she is not sure if they do that anymore.

Loralea Carrera offered pictures. She indicated that she has over 10,000 old pictures to pick from.

Sue Miller told the group that she used to make a calendar every year for family and friends. It became very popular with them.

Roland Moore asked about the committee raising funds to help with the production of a calendar. Mr. Moore will get a price for the production of a calendar.

The group discussed in addition to photos, historical information will need to be added to caption the pictures.

Tammie Gurgiolo made a motion to form a committee to produce a calendar. Roland Moore seconded the motion. All ayes and the motion passed 3 – 0.

Roland Moore will bring a sample of a calendar and look into pricing.

Barbara Edgar will contact the banks to ask them about printers.

The committee decided that the calendar will be the project the commission works on.

Barbara Edgar asked the committee their thoughts on the potential Tea Table development. A brief discussion ensued.

D. Does anyone want to follow through on the porthole Corie Abel was working on?

Barbara Edgar will get a hold of Corie Abel to see where she left off on this project.

Sue Miller stated that Henry Rosenthal was named the Council Liaison to the committee.

Mr. Rosenthal indicated that he has a lifetime membership of the Matecumbe Historical Trust and is always available for questions.
